COVID-19 FACTS AND INFORMATION

Vaccination Policy

As of January 01, 2022, all persons aged 12 years and over will need to show evidence of full COVID-19 vaccination, or have a valid medical exemption, in order to participate in and or gain entry to all St. Jude's Players events and venues used. This includes the Grundy Hall, Fathers Hall, Front of House, backstage and kitchen areas.

St Jude's Players considers full vaccination to be two doses of an ATAGI approved COVID-19 vaccination and will accept the following as evidence of vaccination status:

- COVID-19 digital certificate, as displayed on the MySAGOV app on your smart device.
- A printed copy of your COVID-19 digital certificate with government issued photo identification.
- Official medical exemption from COVID-19 vaccination approved by the Chief Public Health Officer with government issued photo identification.

Children aged under 12 are exempt from this mandate and may attend shows if accompanied by a fully vaccinated adult.

Mask Wearing

Face mask wearing is mandatory and required by SA Health for all patrons aged 12 and over. Please bring a mask and be prepared to wear it over your mouth and nose. A patron is not required to wear a mask if they have a relevant medical condition.

Hand Sanitiser

Hand sanitiser is made available in the front of house areas of the St Jude's Hall as well as backstage. Patrons are encouraged to wash their hands and sanitise frequently.

Venue capacity and seating

We are keeping up to date with all current guidelines and restrictions to stay in line with government COVID-19 rules and recommendations as they change. We have a COVID Safe Plan in place and we ensure all social distancing and density requirements are adhered to at all times.

Other requirements to keep yourself and others safe?

There is an onus on personal responsibility for the health and wellbeing of everyone.

- Do not come to the theatre if you have cold or flu symptoms.
- Wash your hands often and cover coughs and sneezes in your arm.
- Wear a mask and keep 1.5m from others wherever possible.
- Use the COVID Safe check-in QR Code when you arrive.
